Das *simple past* benutzen wir, um Handlungen oder Geschehnisse zu beschreiben, die **bereits geschehen sind**. Signalwörter, die deutlich machen, dass *simple past* benutzt werden muss sind z.B.: Yesterday, last week, last year, 2010, (some time/an hour etc.) ago...

Bildung:

Infinitiv + ed (→ regelmäßige Verben)

- I play**ed** football with my friends yesterday.

2. Verbform (→ unregelmäßige Verben)

- I **ate** ice cream an hour ago.

Negative Sätze und Fragen benutzen Hilfsverb **did**.

- **Did** you **fly** to Turkey this summer? No, I **didn't fly** to Turkey.
